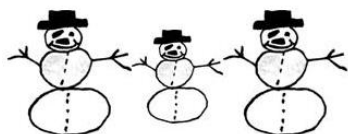

The Eric Hartwell Foundation is a non-profit charitable foundation created in memory of 9 year old Eric Hartwell (diagnosed with a rare form of leukemia and passing away on December 6, 2004) with the goal of providing direct support for the needs of children diagnosed with pediatric blood cancers and being treated at U-M C.S. Mott Children's Hospital in Ann Arbor, Michigan. These needs are identified by our working closely with the Child Life staff, Nursing Staff, and the Office of Community Relations.

We also provide support not provided by the hospital that goes a long way toward improving patient treatment and outcome, including: gift cards to buy various crafts and books, musical instruments, both which become incredibly powerful distractions from treatment or boredom; iPads for children receiving bone marrow transplants so they can communicate with their friends and family; gift cards to Kroger which enables Family Life Specialists to go out to the patient's schools to help educate their classmates about their treatment and to welcome them back. We support enhanced information binders for newly diagnosed patients that parents bring on every visit. We provide iPads for Child and Family staff so they can take pictures and videos of families and create postings on the internet that the children can share with their families & friends. The iPads are also used by patients for distraction during painful procedures. We have also established an annual Eric Hartwell Excellence in 'Pediatric Hematology-Oncology Nursing Award,' with the recipient chosen by their nurse and doctor peers for all they do to provide the best patient/family experience and outcome. Please know we are continuously recognized and thanked by top administrators, doctors, and staff working at C.S. Mott Children's Hospital. We are making a difference!
