

The Eric Hartwell Foundation is a non-profit charitable foundation created in memory of Eric Hartwell, a 9 yr old (diagnosed with a rare form of leukemia and passing away on December 6, 2004) with the goal of providing support to make days happier and brighter for children diagnosed with pediatric blood cancers and



blood disorders who are undergoing treatment at UofM's C.S. Mott Children's Hospital in Ann Arbor, MI. These needs are identified by working closely with the Child and Family Life Team, Nursing Staff, and the Office of Community Relations.

The hospital has shared that our support contributes toward improving patient treatment and outcome by our providing gift cards to buy various craft materials for the activity room and use at bedside — books, and musical instruments, both which become incredibly powerful distractions from treatment or boredom — gaming systems — iPads for children receiving bone marrow transplants so they can communicate with their schools, classmates, family and friends — gift cards to Kroger which enable the Family Life Specialists to go out to the patient's schools to help educate their classmates about their treatment and to welcome them back to the classroom — enhanced information binders for newly diagnosed patients (that parents bring on every visit) — providing iPads for Child and Family staff so they can take pictures and videos of families and create postings on the internet that the children can share with their families & friends, and a laptop to create legacy videos — funding monthly and special event cookie decorating packages — established an annual 'Eric Hartwell Excellence in 'Pediatric Hematology-Oncology Nursing Award,' with the recipient chosen by their nurse and doctor peers for all they do to provide the best patient/family experience and outcome.
